

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

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The GDPR...

- builds upon and fully replaces existing current Act
- addresses the technological advances over the last 20 years
- strengthens security requirements and enforces stricter laws
- introduces much higher penalties
- some good practice has become regulation
- sways from a company focussed to a consumer focussed set of regulation
- requires us to keep evidence of *how* we comply
- is very unlikely to be affected by Brexit
- D-Day is 25th May 2018 – 9 months to go...
- Industry is quoting a 2 years 'lead-in' required
